# Introduction

**Predict:** To say that something will happen in the future.

For example, "I predict (or think) that the peach will taste sweet."

**Hypothesis:** To suggest an idea about cause and effect.

For example, "If the peach is sweet, then I will like it."



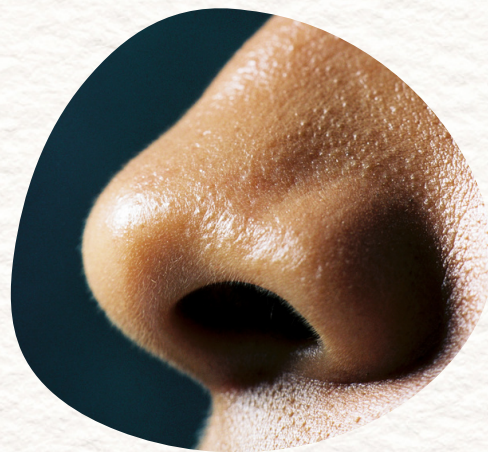

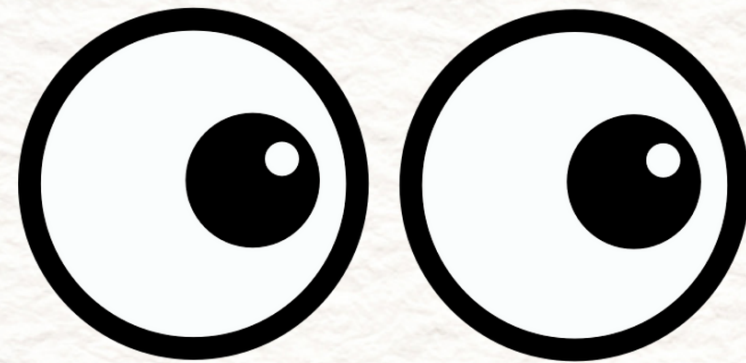

What do you think this vegetable will taste like?


Why do you think it will taste like that?
